Mission Teams In July

In July we hosted four short-term mission teams. They came from Covenant Comm. of AZ, Grace Comm. of AL, Village 7 of CO and Rincon Mountain of AZ. The 57 missionaries helped us with Kids Clubs, English classes, construction and medical clinics. It was a great month of service.

Firing 12 Employees

It has been a very difficult period for our two ministry centers. In recent months we have received little financial support for these two building projects. Because of this we were forced to fire 12 of our Honduran construction workers. This will greatly slow our construction, but most of all it radically impacts the 12 families that now find themselves with no income. It breaks our hearts, but we trust in God's provision and timing.

Our Home Got Burglarized

On July 25th our home was burglarized. The robbers cut our gate lock and smashed in our front door. They ransacked our home and deeply hurt our family emotionally. They stole about \$1,500 in cash, Mike's computer, our DVD player, iPod, iTunes, a watch and more. Nobody was hurt.

Lots Of Medical Clinics

With the help of short-term mission teams we hosted 11 free medical clinics in the month of July. Nearly 400 patients received prayer, evangelism, professional medical care, medicine, health education and the mercy of Jesus Christ.
