## Health Education For Kids

On August 17<sup>th</sup> we hosted a health day for 125 kids at the public school in Armenia Bonito. They received vitamins and treatment for parasitic worms. We taught a gospel message, nutrition, abstinence, dental hygiene and physical fitness.

## Long-Term Solutions

Insufficient and unpredictable income forced us to fire 12 workers who were constructing our two ministry centers. This was hard on their families and a setback for our work. We are now seeking individuals and churches to partner with us through monthly contributions to build two high schools, two churches, two medical clinics, a seminary and a homeless kids center. ## Health Problem For Mike

Mike has a 5 mm cyst on his spine that is pressing on a nerve. It is causing constant numbness and a radical decrease in strength in his left arm, making the arm almost useless. Mike is taking medication and doing therapy. If it worsens Mike will need spinal surgery to remove the cyst. Please pray!

## Summer Mission Teams

Nine short-term mission teams visited La Ceiba during a 12-week period. Those teams consisted of 105 people from six states. In three months these mission teams hosted 20 medical clinics, put on 11 Kids Clubs, taught nine ESL classes, took the kids to the river six times, built three houses, and took the kids to the beach twice. Their passion and desire to serve was infectious.

## Houses For Single Moms

With the help of short-term mission teams this summer we completed three new houses for poor families in Armenia Bonito. Each home was built for a single mom. These families received a large helping of God's mercy, grace and justice.
